- **Give Yourself Guidance** – Don't just start plucking away. Instead, use a pencil to fill in your desired shape so you don't end up over tweezing.

- **Add Color** - Fill them in to give them an extra pop. You want your brows to look noticeable. If you're blonde, make them one shade darker than your
